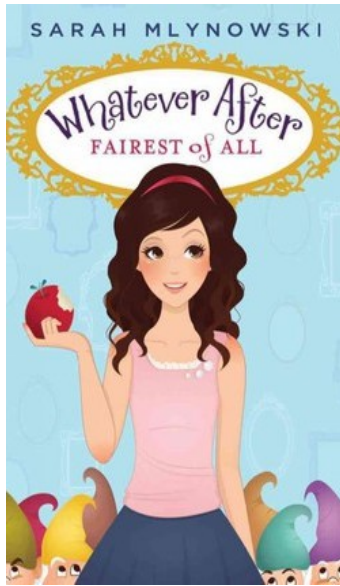

Once upon a time my brother and I were normal kids. The next minute? The mirror in our basement slurped us up and magically trans-

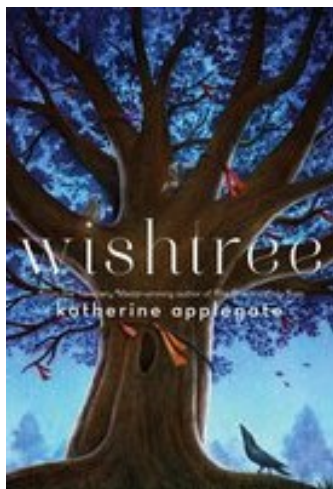
ported us inside Snow White's fairy tale.

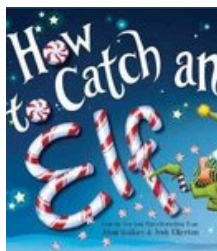
Red is an oak tree who is many rings old. Red is the neighborhood "wishtree"—people write their wishes on

You might say Red has seen it all. Until a new family moves in. Not everyone is welcoming, and Red's experience as a wishtree is more important than ever.

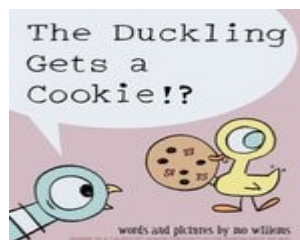
