Children in the Library

We welcome and encourage children to visit the Library, use library resources and services, and attend library programs. Children who have not yet entered **third grade** must be closely supervised by an adult guardian during their visit to the library. Staff members are available to help and support children; however, the Library is not able to provide short- or long-term child care, or be responsible for unattended children.

Disruptive Behavior

Children who are unable or unwilling to care for themselves or exhibit disruptive behavior may not be left unattended on Library premises. If disruptive behavior continues after one warning from library staff, the child will be asked to leave the library premises, whether accompanied or not. Second inci-

dents of disruptive behavior, or refusal to obey staff directions, will result in minimum 30 day suspension of library privileges including presence on library premises.

Library Premises includes Courtyard

Use of the library requires respect for others who are also enjoying the library premises and services. Behavior becomes unacceptable when it interferes with other persons' use of the library, when it could result in injury to oneself or others, or when it could result in loss or damage to customer or library property.

Behavior

Certain activities are inconsistent with the mission of the library and will not be tolerated.

These include:

- Disruptive behavior, such as running, threatening or harassing behavior, talking loudly, using vulgar or profane language.
- Bringing food or drinks into the library.
- The use of basketballs, soccer balls, footballs, baseballs, skateboards, bicycles, roller skates, or scooters on library property.
- Soliciting of any kind including seeking or collecting signatures for a petition.
- Smoking or the use of other tobacco products, alcohol or illegal drugs in the library or on the premises.
- Inappropriate or unsafe use of furniture including moving of furniture or sitting on tables.

Telephone Use

Patrons may not use the library telephones to make or receive personal phone calls except in cases of true emergency as determined by the library staff.

Wednesdays with Jewell

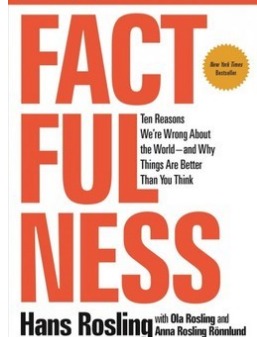
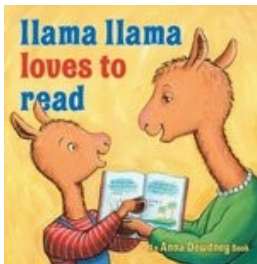
Wednesdays are special at Vinita Public Library. For over ten years, Jewell Morgan has shared her time and talents with the children who gather after-school in the Heritage Room.
